

Privacy Policy

General Statement

This policy relates to our privacy practices in connection with our website, www.ronaldchisholmlaw.com. It does not describe information collection practices in relation to other websites, including those linked to or from the Site.

Your privacy is important to us, and our policy is simple. The law office of Ronald R. Chisholm does not collect any personal information about you when you visit this website unless you specifically choose to provide that information.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

The office of Ronald R. Chisholm does not collect any personal information about you other than that which you provide voluntarily. For example, we will retain your e-mail address if you complete the contact form and submit your contact information to us. We also retain other information provided to us by you in connection with the delivery of legal services to you personally such as that contained in the various forms found on the services page of this website.

Information provided by you is used solely for the purpose for which it is intended. Such information is not shared with any third party for commercial purposes.

Collection and Use of Technical information

The server on which this website is located collects and saves only the default information normally provided by web server software. Such information may include the originating IP address, the date and time of your visit, the web pages visited on our website and documents downloaded from it. If enabled by your web browser, the website may place “cookies” (simple text files) on your computer so that the website can remember you on subsequent visits. You may disable the ability of your computer to receive “cookies”.

The offices of Ronald R. Chisholm will make no attempt to identify individual visitors to the Site or associate the technical information referred to above with any individual.

This information is used only for statistical and administrative purposes and to assist in making enhancements to the visitors’ experience with the website.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

Security

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.
